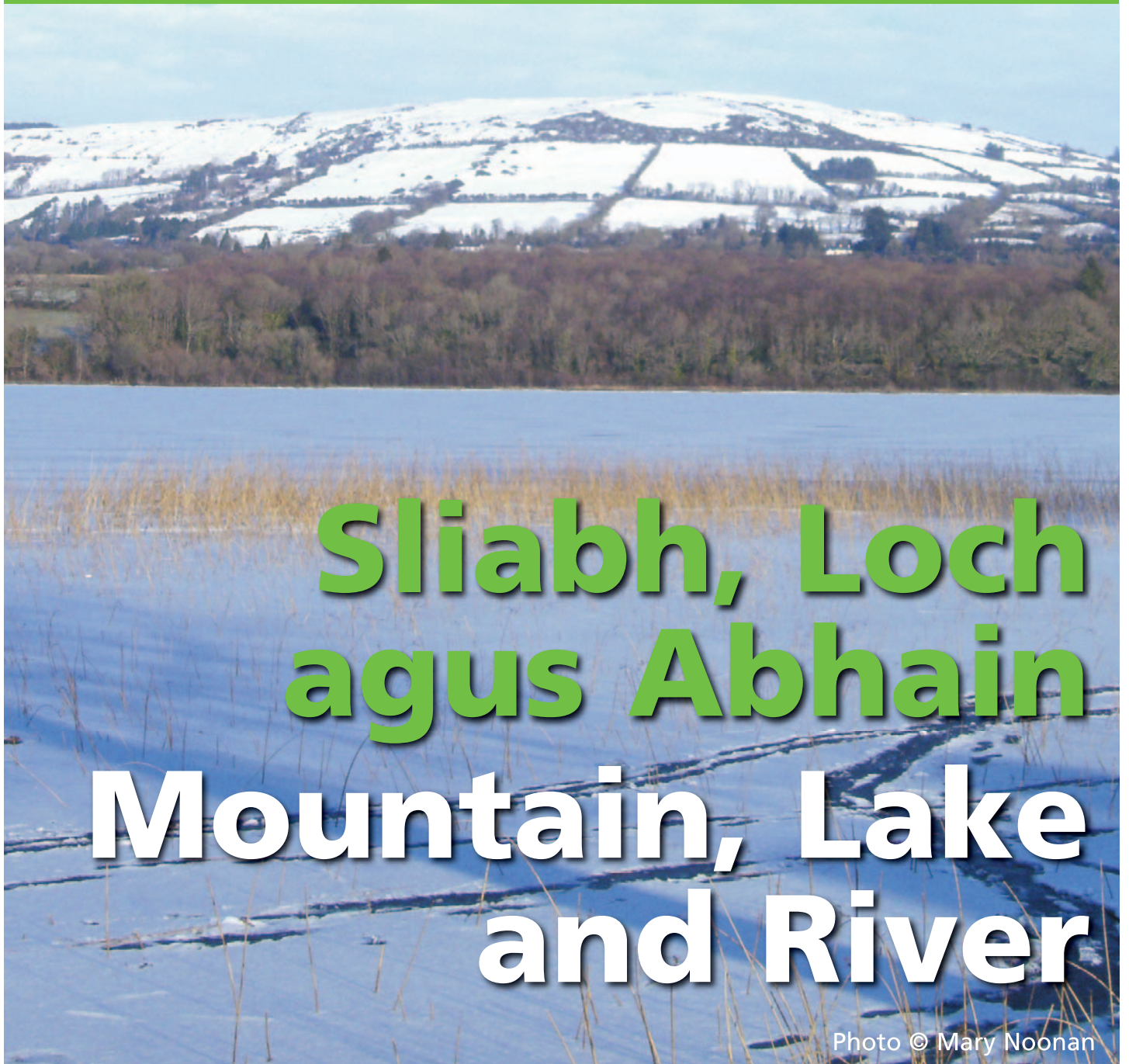

The ninth Aughty Gathering will open with a welcome by **Pierce Joyce**, guide and researcher with the Irish Workhouse Centre, Portumna.

Our keynote speaker is **Paul Gosling**, professional archaeologist, lecturer, and author who will open the day with a very provocative presentation asking why does our heritage need to be managed by acronym.

Kilchreest-based community and heritage activist **Kevin Cunningham** will present on some of his recent archaeological discoveries in the Aughtys.

Donal Boland is a marine archaeologist who has undertaken extensive research and mapping of Lough Derg and the Mid-Shannon.

John Joe Conwell is a local historian and author and acknowledged expert on the Great Famine in South East Galway. He is also involved with the Ireland Reaching Out Project.

Dolores O'Shea is a returned Portumna native, now working with the Ireland Reaching Out project for Offaly Local Development. Dolores is a member of IGSI (Irish Society of Genealogists in Ireland).

Christy Cunniffe is a self-employed archaeologist and heritage consultant and works as Field Monument Advisor for Galway County Council.

Zena Hctor is a self-employed heritage consultant and environmental specialist. Zena will speak on the award winning Lough Derg heritage trail undertaken by her for Galway, Clare, and Tipperary local authorities.

Mary de Lourdes Fahy RSM is a member of the Sisters of Mercy in Gort. A graduate of UCG, she is well-known as a local historian and teacher.

The Irish Workhouse Centre is located on St Brigid's Road, a 10 minute walk from the Bank of Ireland Corner. The Centre is just past the schools.

From the Dublin/Athlone/Ballinasloe direction, the Workhouse is on the left as you enter the town.

From the Loughrea/Galway direction, on entering Portumna, turn left at Al Hayes Motors, signposted for Ballinasloe. Then take the first right. You will see the Workhouse on your left.

From Tipperary, drive over Portumna Bridge, continue straight, turn right at Bank of Ireland and continue on. The Workhouse is on your right.

From the Woodford/Co Clare direction, continue straight ahead as you enter Portumna, turn left at Bank of Ireland, continue on and the Irish Workhouse Centre is on your right.
