

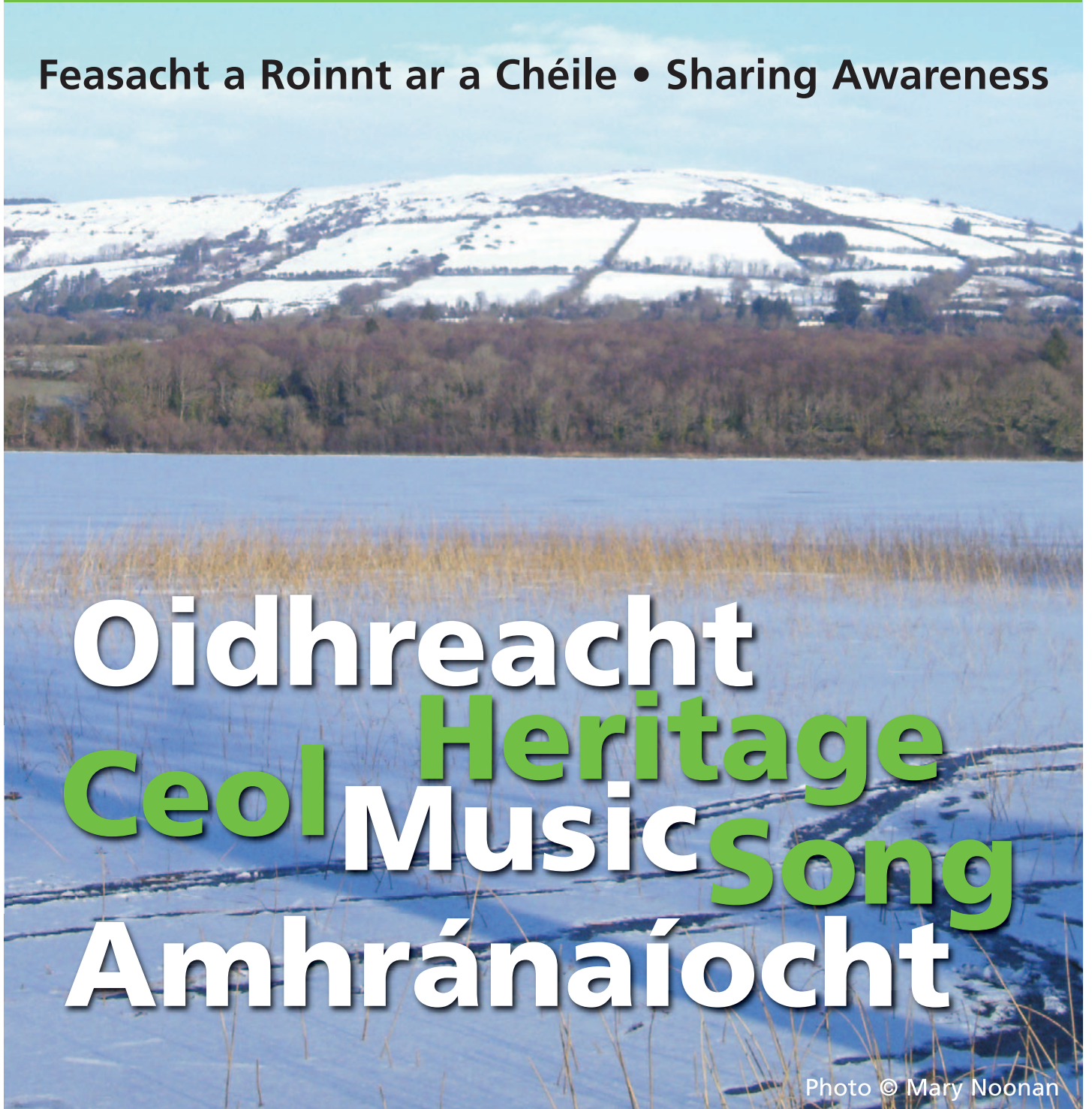

Scaip an t-eolas seo ar dhaoine eile!

Michael Starrett

Príomhfheidhmeannach na Comhairle Ealaíon is ea an t-aoichainteoir Michael Starrett.

D'fhág sé an ollscoil le cáilíochtaí san eiceolaíocht agus sa bhitheolaíocht agus bhain sé amach cáilíochtaí iarchéime san oideachas agus i réimse bainistíochta comhshaoil. Tá 30 bliain caite aige ag obair ar fhorbairt polasaithe agus ar bhainistíú chúrsaí oidhreacht. Bhain sé céim mháistreachta amach i nDeá-Chleachtas Bainistíochta i gcomhair le Coláiste na Tríonóide le Foras Bainistíochta na hÉireann.

Is ball den ghrúpa Landscape Institute ALI (an Bhreatain Mhór) agus d'Institiúid Tírdhreacha na hÉireann mar aon leis an Institute of Sport, Parks and Leisure (MISPAL). D'oibrigh sé in Éirinn, i dTuaisceart Éireann agus san Albain. Tá an-taithi aige fosta ar chúrsaí comhshaoil san Eoraip. Tá sé ina bhall de Chónaidhm Páirceanna Náisiúnta agus Dúlra na hEorpa, grúpa trasEorpach a bhfuil 400 ball ann ó 38 tír éagsúil. Ba é an chéad Éireannach é a bhí ina uachtarán ar Chónaidhm Páirceanna Náisiúnta agus Fiadhúlra na hEorpa, ról a bhí aige idir 2002 agus 2005. Is ball é fosta de choimisiúin domhanda ar aontas idirnáisiúnta a bhaint amach maidir le caomhnú na fiadhúlra i limistéir atá faoi chosaint speisialta (an IUCN). Tá staidéir déanta ar fud an domhain ag Michael ar dhliethe a bhaineann le córas a cheadaíonn bainistíú agus forbairt an dúlra agus na timpeallachta nádúrtha is cultúrtha ar bhealach atá inmharthana.

Tá cónaí aige i gCill Chainnigh lena bhean chéile, Giliane agus a dtriúr clainne.

Tim Collins

Ceoltóir agus fear léinn is ea Tim Collins a bhfuil cónaí air i gCroisín, Co. an Chláir Clare. Tá cáil náisiúnta agus idirnáisiúnta air mar cheoltóir traidisiúnta. Tugann sé ranganna i gceoil an chonsairtín agus bíonn tóir air ar fud an domhain. Seineann sé ina aonair agus le Banna Céilí Chill Fhionnúrach. Tá taifead go leor déanta aige.

Bhain Tim céim onórachta amach sa teagasc in 1990 agus bhí sé ina mhúinteoir bitheolaíochta agus matamaitice ar feadh cúig bliana déag. Sa bhliain 2003, bhain sé onórachta amach i gcéim mháistreachta in Ollscoil Luimnigh. Déanann sé teagasc ar chlár MA agus BA na hollscoile sin anois.

Tá céim dochtúireachta go díreach bainte amach aige le hIonad an Léinn Éireannaigh, in Ollscoil Éireann Gaillimh. Chaith sé cúig bliana ag déanamh taighde ar Shliabh Eachtaí agus dhírigh sé ina thráchtas ar bhealach úr inniúil le staidéir a dhéanamh ar léann cheoil thraidisiúnta na hÉireann trí spás, áit agus smaointí mar iad a áireamh sa taighde.

Michael Starrett

Michael Starrett is the Chief Executive of the Heritage Council of Ireland.

A graduate ecologist and biologist with post graduate qualifications in education and landscape management he has 30 years experience in the areas of heritage management and policy development. He holds a Masters in Management Practice from Trinity College Dublin and the Irish Management Institute.

His professional qualifications include membership of the Landscape Institute ALI(UK) and the Irish

Landscape Institute as well as the Institute of Sport, Parks and Leisure (MISPAL). In addition to a career path that has seen him work in Northern Ireland, Scotland and the Republic of Ireland, he has extensive European experience through his membership of the Federation of National and Nature Parks of Europe, a pan European body with 400 members in 38 different countries. He was the first Irishman to be elected as President of the Federation from 2002-2005. He is also a member of the IUCN's World Commission on Protected Areas. Michael has traveled extensively studying legislation and systems that allow the sustainable management and development of cultural and natural landscapes.

Michael lives in Kilkenny with his wife Giliane and their three children.

Tim Collins

Tim Collins is a musician and academic who lives in Crusheen, County Clare. As a traditional musician, he has earned a national and international reputation both as a performer and as a tutor on the anglo concertina. As a solo musician and as a member of the Kilfenora Céilí Band, he has toured and recorded extensively.

He completed his honours teaching degree in 1990 and spent fifteen years as a teacher of Biology and Mathematics. In 2003, he received a first class honours MA in music performance at the University of Limerick, where he now occasionally tutors on both BA and MA programmes.

He has just completed his PhD at the Centre for Irish Studies, NUI Galway. Based on five years of research in Sliabh Aughty, his thesis proposes a new and innovative approach to the study of Irish traditional music by focusing on the centrality of space, place and related concepts in such practices.
